

Poster Presentation Guidelines

The conference committees welcome your contribution to the ICGAB event. Please read these instructions carefully to help ensure your presentation is a success.

1. The author should prepare A3-size posters in advance
2. Register upon arrival at the conference.
3. Please bring your poster to the Poster room at least 2 hours prior to your poster session. To locate your assigned poster board, look for number of your abstract was assigned. It is important that you DO NOT move locations. The numbers allow attendees to easily locate the poster presentation they are interested in reviewing.
4. Posters should be well laid out and formatted, visually appealing with the use of color, and present a professional image. Do not laminate the poster because of potential glare from overhead lights
5. Keep in mind that your information must be concise; focus on summarizing the information of your presentation.
6. Select the most notable aspects of your research because not all the information can be presented. For presentations on research, usually the Results and Discussion sections are the emphasis of the poster presentation. Next in emphasis would usually be the Conclusion, Methodology, Abstract, and Literature Review.
7. Posters should not contain arts and craft items such as glitter, handwritten or hand-colored items, pictures cut out of a magazine, and so forth.
8. No audiovisual equipment is permitted for poster presentations.
9. The author must remain by his or her poster board for the duration of the poster session. The judge will come to your location for discussions and poster evaluation. The authors will then hold discussions with the registrants who are circulating among the poster boards.
